## Alert Neighbors Program

In August, several Wedgewood residents met with the city personnel responsible for the **Safe Neighborhood Program**. After reviewing the program, the WW Board has voted to purchase signs that will be posted at each of our eight entrances. Success of the program requires that we have volunteers who are willing to be block captains. ## **What Is Not Legal to Drive on the Street?**

### **City Ordinance 23-21**

Go-Carts, Golf carts, All-Terrain Vehicles (3 or 4 wheel ATV's), mini-motorcycles, motorcycles designed for off road use, or any other "play vehicle", whether powered by an electric motor or a gas engine, CANNOT be legally operated on city streets or highways in the state of Oklahoma. A license plate on a motorized device DOES NOT make it street legal to operate. The size of the vehicle, the engine size, DOT approved equipment and insurance requirements dictate what can legally be operated on public roadways.

***Contact local law enforcement  
if you have any questions.***

Any adult violating this law in the city of Broken Arrow can be cited for violation of city ordinance 23-21. Any parent/guardian of a minor 17 years of age or younger who is observed in violation of this ordinance can be issued a citation. If you notice someone in violation of this law, you should call the police non-emergency number -- 451-8200.

## **City Action Center**

The city of Broken Arrow operates an Action Center to deal with any type of nuisances (see city code below) or code violations. The phone number to call is 258-3587 and it is available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. All calls are handled in an anonymous manner.

In order to process a complaint, you must provide your name, address, and telephone number. They then need the address that you are reporting the complaint on and the nature of the complaint. They need the exact address – street and house number.

When reporting an inoperable automobile, they need to know if it is in the driveway, the yard, or the street. It is also helpful IF you can provide, make, model, color, and tag number.

If reporting a noise issue, you should call the police non-emergency number 451-8200.
