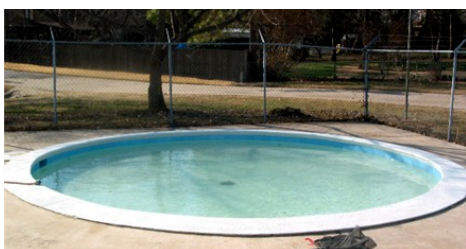

Request from your Neighbor

The Wedgewood Board has been asked to pass on a request to all WW residents. Please be aware of "trash holidays" (see below). These are holidays for the BA Trash personnel. So, please do not put out your trash on these days and you are also requested to not put out your trash the day before pickup, thus giving the occasional stray animal the opportunity to scatter your trash through your neighbor's yard.

News from the City of Broken Arrow

Annual **BA trash bag distribution** will begin Monday, April 17 thru Saturday, April 22 plus Monday, April 24 through 29 from 8am to 6pm at the city's Maintenance Center at 1700 W Detroit (behind Rhema). Bring the post card you will be receiving in the mail from the city sometime after April 1.

The annual "**Free Spring Clean-up Day**" for BA has been set for **Saturday, May 7** at the Maintenance Center. BA residents can drive in with trucks, trailers or car loads of yard trash, old furniture and other items (no appliances with hazardous gases, such as Freon.) City crews will be available to help with unloading.

City Holidays- Trash Pick-up

If a holiday falls on a Monday, there will be no trash pickup that day. Those with Monday-Thursday curbside service will have trash picked up that week on Tuesday and Thursday. Those with Tuesday-Friday service will have pickups on Wednesday and Friday.

If a holiday falls on a Tuesday, Thursday or Friday, customers who normally get curbside pickup on that day will have only one pickup during the week.

The holiday schedule for the 2006 calendar year is as follows: New Year's Day, M.L. King Day, Good Friday (April 14), Memorial Day (May 29), Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day (Sept. 4), Veteran's Day (Nov. 12), Thanksgiving (Nov. 23-24), and Christmas (dec. 25).
