New Roof

The board has received recent inquiries regarding what is approved roofing for Wedgewood. The following is copied from our covenants (also available on our website):

"Section D. Self-seal composition shingles will be permitted on roofs, as long as they are not less than 235#. No roof pitch shall be lower than 2 1/2-12 on any structure erected on any lot, unless architectural design of such structure designates any standard [mansard] roof."
