Many of our neighbors enjoy using these public areas for exercising or just taking a leisurely stroll. Sadly though, some use these areas to deposit leaves, tree limbs and even trash. These areas are the property of the city and are covered by the city ordinance below. Let's all do our share to keep the park and greenbelt areas tidy and a pleasant place to spend time with our families.

Sec. 12-6. - Unlawful deposits.

It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, sweep or otherwise deposit, into or upon the streets, alleys, parkings, sidewalks or other public places of the city, any garbage, trash, paper, rubbish, grass, weeds, tree trimmings, dirt, crates, boxes or other refuse of any kind. It shall likewise be unlawful for any person to deposit any garbage, trash or other refuse upon private property, whether owned by such person or not, within the limits of the city, unless the same shall be enclosed in a suitable container. (Code 1970, §§ 9-6, 9-15)

Broken Arrow's free dump day is tentatively scheduled May 14, 2011. All trash and yard debris will need to be taken to the Tulsa dump. Just show them your drivers license with a Broken Arrow address and there will be no charge. Be aware that the date may change so please confirm by calling 918-251-5311.
